This time we're showcasing our very own St Edmund's Nursery School and Children's Centre! Here, Sian Hudson, Executive Headteacher of St Edmund's and Lilycroft Nursery Schools, tells us about the exciting 'Nursery at Night' event that they run for children and their families:

One of our favourite annual events at Lilycroft Nursery School is 'Nursery at Night'. We love it so much that this year we decided to hold it at St Edmund's too!

Children and their families come back to the Nursery in the dark to find that everything has been magically transformed with fairy lights, lanterns, and projections. We also have UV lights so that everything glows in the dark - face paint, drawings, playdough, and even water!

We run a range of activities for everyone to enjoy. The disco is always popular – the children love dancing with ribbons and glo sticks! Also firm favourites are: toasting marshmallows over an open fire (enjoyed with hot chocolate!); a treasure hunt with torches, and candlelight stories. Delicious food is available to buy, supplied by local people who rent a stall for a small fee.



We ended the evening with everyone coming together outside to sing 'Twinkle Twinkle Little Star' followed by a grand finale of fireworks! Many of our staff stay late to support with the event, and they all agree that the hard work and long day are all worth it. The children's excited faces and the appreciation from all our families shows how much they enjoy and value our work and it gives us all a sense of belonging!
